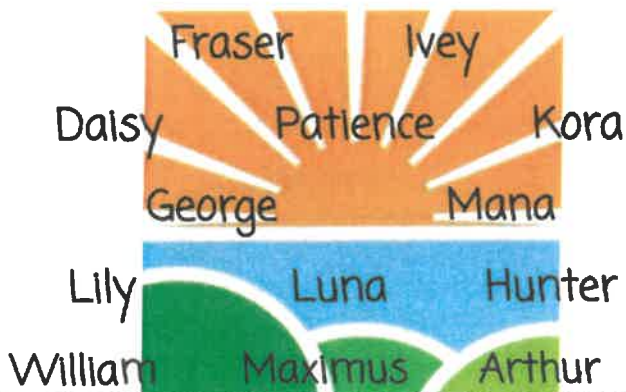
Kia Ora whānau!

Mokau School have decided to host our very own inaugural School Swimming Sports competition! This event will be held at the school pool on Friday 25th February.

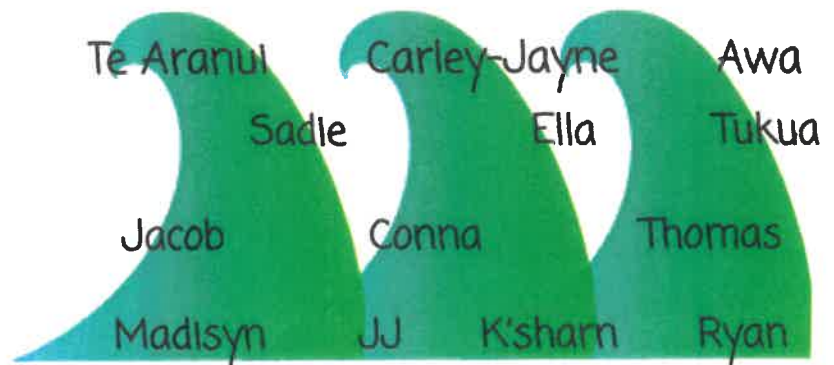
Tamariki are encouraged to come dressed in their house colours and there will be a prize for the best-dressed! Please see below for your child(ren)'s house and house colours.
