#### Reports

#### Attendance

A new feature of reports was a graph showing the students' attendance and an information sheet highlighting the effect of learner absence on learning. Below is the school policy relating to attendance.

#### **Student Attendance**

The Education and Training Act 2020 requires that all children six years old and over must attend school. Once enrolled, it is compulsory for children to attend school regularly.

Mokau School encourages students to participate fully in school life. Students are expected to attend school when required, and to be on time for classes. This policy applies for off-site activities as well, such as EOTC activities.

We monitor the daily attendance of students to:

- ensure their safety both in getting to school, and in accounting for them in an emergency
- identify students with achievement, engagement, or other issues
- meet our legal responsibilities.

Parents and guardians also have legal obligations to ensure their children attend school. The school expects parents to:

- notify the school if their child is going to be absent by phone, text, or email by 9 am
- try to arrange appointments etc. outside school hours or in holidays
- work with the school to manage any attendance issues.

Absences are usually unjustified unless the student is too sick to attend school, or has suffered a bereavement. Sometimes a student might be out of class but should still be marked present, such as when attending a medical appointment. Holidays should only be taken during school holidays.

#### **Rapid Antigen Tests**

If you require any tests please phone the school to arrange contactless pick up. We are happy to provide an additional point of access for tests for our community in a contactless way to make access easier.

# **Covid information and support**

If your child is feeling unwell or has a cough, runny nose, sore throat or is sneezing **please keep them at home** until they are well. It is recommended to get tested. If you need support because you have Covid or are a household contact please contact the kura. We can arrange food parcels and RAT for you.
