COMPETITION RULES

- Starting time of competition is 1am Thursday 1st September.
- Weigh in day is Saturday 3rd September between 12 noon and 3pm at the Mahoenui Hall. All pigs must be at the weigh station between these times.
- No pigs will be accepted after 3pm.
- The Animal health board (AHB) have the right to test all presented pigs for TB.

The finer details

- Single entry (One hunter per entry).
 - Entry fee \$35 must accompany entry form.
 - Maximum of two (2) boars per entry. Second Boar entry of \$10 on the day will be allowed.
 - Boars only.
 - Minimum Weight 30kg.
 - Pigs weighing less than 30kg are only eligible to enter Best Tusk category.
 - All pigs must be wild.
 - All pigs must be presented clean gutted with nuts in.
 - All carcasses must be whole.
 - All boars must be caught within the stated times of competition.
 - All boars must be caught by the person weighing in.
 - No trapping boars.
 - In the event of a tie, the first boar weighed in collects the prize.
 - All boars must be hanging at the time of prize giving.
 - No decomposing boars (must be edible).
 - If judges reject pig they have the right to reject other pigs.
 - Ridgeline judges' decision is final.
 - No badly mutilated pigs will be accepted.
- ** Prize winners must be present to collect prizes **
